The governing body is made up of:

- parent governors (elected by parents)
- staff representatives (elected by school staff)
- local authority governors (appointed by the local authority)
- community governors (members of the local community appointed by the governing body)

Winter Uniform	
Grey trousers or shorts White or grey shirt / Royal Blue Polo Shirt Royal blue pullover / sweatshirt	Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers White blouse or shirt Royal blue cardigan, jumper / sweatshirt
Summer Uniform	
Same as the winter uniform but shorts can be worn and white or royal blue polo shirts may be worn.	Same as the winter uniform or a summer dress of blue and white check or stripes
Sun hats are also available from the school. These are highly recommended for sunny days.	
PE Kit	
Plain dark shorts and a white or blue top. Pumps or trainers. Tracksuits can be worn in winter. Earrings must be covered with tape, for safety	
 <p>Important PLEASE, PLEASE make sure every item of clothing worn to school is clearly marked with the child's name. This is easily done by writing on the manufacturers label with a marking pen; there is usually room.</p>	

Please note boots may be worn to school so long as they are changed for shoes once in school.
