Important Notice - On **Monday September 28th 2009** of this week it was not possible for the school bus to get down Holbrook Road to pick up the bus children to go home. Unfortunately cars had been parked both sides of the road blocking access. Parents and guardians will be aware from previous communications that they have been asked not to do this. Such actions are not only inconvenient for other road users they are also potentially very dangerous. If it is absolutely necessary to bring the car to pick up the children please ensure you are parked sensibly and safely for all concerned. Please note that access to the school is also possible via the gate adjoining the memorial park. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Book Fair - Please note that the Scholastic Book Fair will be open to parents next week from **Monday 5th—Thursday 8th October 2009**. It will be open during the day for the children to look at the books and open to parents after school in **the hall on Tuesday and Wednesday** and in the **Nursery FS1 Nursery room on Monday and Thursday** (due to after school activities in the hall). If you are unable to visit the book fair (due to work commitments etc) brochures will be sent home this week with the children to enable you to order a book.

Harvest Festival - **THIS Wednesday October 7th 2009 at 2:15pm** Reverend Wilkinson will be leading our Harvest Festival. Parents, guardians and grandparents have been very generous in supporting our harvest celebrations and I would ask if they could do so again this year. Please support us by bringing in fruit, vegetables, tins and packets that we can then sell after school with the book fair. The proceeds of this sale will again go to the Salvation Army's local Christmas appeal for vulnerable people.

Young Leaders Award - During the week 30 children from Years 5 and 6 underwent training from Tracey Palmer (School Sports Coordinator, Bilton High School) to gain a 'Young Leaders Award.' These children worked hard during the day (and looked quite tired by the end of it!) to develop the skills to organise and lead fun games for infants and year 3 and 4 children during lunchtime and morning plays. We hope to announce who was successful in gaining the award shortly.

Dinner Money - Just a reminder that all cheques now need to be made out to Long Lawford Primary School. School Meals are now £1.70 each or £8.50 for a full week.
