Mrs Vine talked to the children on Teams about the vital work of the Foodbank and how important food donations are, in order to keep this local Foodbank running. This is why our goodwill and support is so essential.

With this in mind, we have decided to support the Long Lawford Foodbank this year, as this directly supports our immediate community. As part of our Harvest celebrations we would like to collect as much as possible of the following long life food items: dried pasta, rice, tinned foods, packet foods e.g. soups, instant mash, noodles, custard powder, long life fruit juices, coffee, tea bags, crisps, biscuits, cereals and jams.
