COVID-19 Road Map Changes

Dear Families,

As you are all aware Central Government is making changes to ease lockdown restrictions further on Monday 17th May 2021. However, as far as the school is operating, very few changes will be made from next week and very few changes are likely to happen for the rest of this academic year.

The only minor changes we will be making to our risk assessment after May half term are:

- Children can bring lunch bags (as well as boxes).
- Day trips can start but must be in bubbles, with only staff from the bubbles and no parents or volunteers.
- Staff will continue to wear masks on door or gate duties, in communal areas and in class if they are more comfortable doing so.
- Parents/carers should continue to wear masks on the school site and keep social distancing.
- Parents/carers will continue using a one way system to try to maintain a 2m distance from other families.
- Maintain year group bubbles where possible.
- Continue with additional hygiene procedures throughout the school day, including additional cleaning where needed.
- Start and end of day as well as breaktime and lunchtimes will remain staggered.

All documents will be updated and uploaded onto our school website in due course. Unfortunately, schools continue to be 'vectors of transmission' and COVID-19 is not going away even though cases are dropping. Long Lawford Primary School has done quite well in playing our part to stop the spread of the virus in our local community, but the virus is still out there. We are aware that other schools in the locality are still needing to partially close due to positive COVID cases. Let's continue to follow the guidance and keep staying safe together.
