Harlow from reception class got this amazing trophy at his football. Amazing work Harlow, well done!

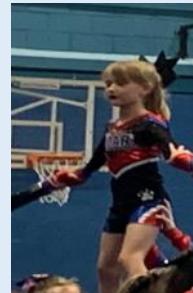


This is Alex from Year 3 with his swimming certificate. Alex has achieved RED Award. We are really proud of you Alex, keep it up!
