Look What We've Been Doing...

In Nursery we have been making new friends and learning about ourselves and our families. We have drawing self-portraits and represented our family member with wooden peg dolls. We enjoy singing and joining in the with actions. Our favourite song is 5 Little Monkeys jumping on the bed. Well done to all the Nursery children for settling in so well!

We have started phonics and the children have been having a go at writing letters SATPIN. In maths the children will be learning numbers to 10 and writing them. We have also been looking at vegetables and we tried some fruits and vegetables just like Oliver in the story of 'Oliver's vegetables'. We will also be looking at Julian Donaldson stories and sharing our favourite stories.

Year 1 have been enjoying writing descriptions about the beach and sea. We have been looking at writing numbers as words in maths. We have enjoyed topic days looking at David Attenborough and the climate.

In Year 2, we had an exciting day with an artist this Wednesday! We used recycled materials to create a piece of art all about saving the Earth. We wrote a poem and a letter, all about how important it is to protect our planet. We've been working hard on place value in Maths and learned about David Attenborough in History. What a busy few weeks we've had!

Year 3 have had lots of fun designing, making and flying kites using recycled materials. We have also been working really hard writing a diary entry using lots of different skills and representing numbers using dienes in Maths.

Year 4 have been extending their understanding of Place Value in Maths and writing a recount of our Climate protests inspired by the book 'Greta and the Giants' by Zoe Tucker. In topic, we have been learning about the effects of climate change on our planet.

Year 5 have been busy learning about Greta Thunberg in our English lessons, debating whether she was right to take time off school for her climate protest or not. This is linked to our whole school topic of Climate Chaos. We have been working on addition and subtraction in Maths and learning about Earth and Space in Science.

In Year 6 we have been learning all about Greta Thunberg and her efforts to halt the climate crisis. We wrote letters to Mrs Stringer with ideas as to how LLPS could become more environmentally friendly. We really enjoyed completing our Swimming Lessons. It has been a real treat to have Miss Ioana teaching us French and Mr Grady teaching us Music. A real balance of learning!
